

Lesson Plans

Total learning time: Seven (7) weeks

Lesson 0: Welcome! Free consultation discussing your personal plan that you may like to adapt around the original plan. We will also start with a simple exercise to get your first hands-on approach toward the instrument. **NOTE:** These lesson plans are **not** conventional in regard to the grade system: your lessons, your desires.

Lesson 1: Your Song! Start by learning a song of your choice! We will focus on this chosen piece for the remainder of the lessons and adapt your knowledge around it. The entire lesson will be focused around letting you get to know this song better than you ever have before.

Lesson 2: The beginning of theory! Don't worry, we will still relate your chosen piece to the practise of theory to make the patterns of music clear. We will dive into posture, scales, chords, and even sheet music if you're willing to learn.

Lesson 3: Back on track! Using your recently gained knowledge of theory, we will see how you've improved in regard to your playing style and work further on your chosen song, hopefully covering the ending by this time. *Technical proficiency is vital for constructing a clean and impressive performance.*

Lesson 4: The return of theory! We will cover more scales, more chord types, bettering your posture to perfection, and harnessing your sight reading. Then we will apply what you have learned to your chosen song.

Lesson 5: Almost there! We will get closer to completing your song of choice. This is where your improvements are *really* noticeable. You will be able to play better than you ever imagined. We will additionally harness your theory knowledge even further to get over the final hurdle.

Lesson 6: A Work of Art! Congratulations. You should now be able to perform your chosen song to a good standard. Just remember, Elton didn't become Elton in six weeks... becoming a fluent player or a rock'n'roll hall of famer takes time, practice, motivation, dedication, and listening to as much music as possible to understand the industry context regarding your favourite playing styles. Good luck, and of course, have fun with your new musical abilities!
